TALENT ACQUISITION (REFERRAL) PROGRAM:

At Regional Health we strive to attract and retain top talent and appreciate referrals from our caregivers. The Referral Program provides caregivers with an opportunity to submit a referral and become eligible for a cash bonus that is payable after six months of employment by the new hire. Eligible positions vary and the bonus ranges from \$500-\$2,500.

ABOUT REGIONAL HEALTH:

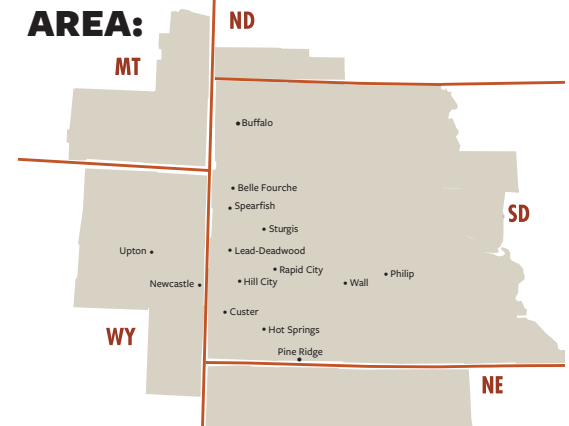
